## WAC 220-47-31100J Purse seine--Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions WAC 220-47-311, effective 1:00 p.m. October 29 through November 8, 2014, it is unlawful to fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with purse seine gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 7 and 7A.

### NEW SECTION

## WAC 220-47-40100J Reef nets—Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-47-401, effective midnight October 29 through November 8, 2014, it is unlawful to fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with reef net gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 7 and 7A.

## NEW SECTION

## WAC 220-47-41100B Gillnet--Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-47-411, effective midnight October 29 through November 8, 2014, it is unlawful to fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with gillnet gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 7 and 7A.

### REPEALERS

The following sections of the Washington Administrative Code are repealed effective 12:01 a.m. November 9, 2014:

WAC 220-47-31100J Purse seine--Open periods. WAC 220-47-40100J Reef net—Open periods. WAC 220-47-41100B Gillnet--Open periods.

#### **EMERGENCY RULE ONLY**

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

**Reasons for this finding**: The non-treaty share of chum in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 7 and 7A is expected to be harvested by the date of this closure. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
