Reasons for this finding: Beginning the week of October 12, 2014, purse seine and gillnet openers have occurred weekly in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 12 and 12B. In addition to Areas 12 and 12B Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 12C was scheduled to open during the week of November 2, 2014. Based on current catch numbers the non-treaty share is expected to be achieved without opening 12C. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

WAC 220-47-31100K Purse seine--Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions WAC 220-47-311, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with purse seine gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 12C.

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-47-41100C Gillnet-Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-47-411, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with gillnet gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 12C.

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

Reasons for this finding: Beginning the week of October 12, 2014, purse seine and gillnet openers have occurred weekly in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 12 and 12B. In addition to Areas 12 and 12B Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 12C was scheduled to open during the week of November 2, 2014. Based on current catch numbers the non-treaty share is expected to be achieved without opening 12C. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
