WAC 220-47-31100M Purse seine -- Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-47-311, effective 6:01 p.m. November 19, 2014, until further notice, it is unlawful to fish for or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with purse seine gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 8D, 10 and 11.

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-47-41100E Gillnet – Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-47-411, effective 6:01 p.m. November 19, 2014, until further notice, it is unlawful to fish for or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with gillnet gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 8D.

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

Reasons for this finding: There are not enough harvestable quotas remaining in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 10 and 11 to provide for a commercial purse seine fishery. Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 8D is closing due to concerns about not reaching egg-take goals at the Tulalip Hatchery. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
