## NEW SECTION

## WAC 220-47-41100G Gillnet--Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-47-411, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to take, fish for or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes with gillnet gear in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 7B except that the area is open to commercial gillnet fishing for salmon from 4:00 p.m. December 3 to 4:00 p.m. December 5, 2014.

#### REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective 4:01 p.m. December 5, 2014:

WAC 220-47-41100G Gillnet—Open periods.

#### EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

**Reasons for this finding**: This emergency rule is to allow the harvest of remaining non-treaty share of Nooksack and Samish chum as agreed to with the tribal co-managers in Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 7B. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules. (14-334, 12/3/2014)
