NEW SECTION

WAC 220-310-20000D Exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River sturgeon. Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-310-200:

- (1) June 19 through June 21, June 26 through June 28, and July 3 through July 5, 2015, it is permissible to retain white sturgeon between 38-inches minimum and 54-inches maximum fork length caught in those waters of the Columbia River and tributaries from Bonneville Dam upstream to sturgeon spawning Sanctuary boundary located 1.8 miles downstream of The Dalles Dam.
- (2) Effective immediately until further notice, except for the specific dates described in subsection (1) of this section, it is unlawful to retain sturgeon caught in those waters of the Columbia River and tributaries from Bonneville Dam upstream to The Dalles Dam. Catch and release is permissible except from May 1 through July 31, 2015 in the sturgeon spawning Sanctuary located from The Dalles Dam downstream 1.8 miles.

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed:

WAC 220-310-20000Z Exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River sturgeon.
