## NEW SECTION

**WAC 220-310-19500Q Exceptions to statewide rules**—**Upper Wheeler Reservoir.** Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-310-195, effective April 25 through June 30, 2015, it is permissible to fish in the waters of Upper Wheeler Reservoir subject to the following provisions:

(1) Fishing is open to fly fishing only.

(2) Trout: Catch and release only.

(3) All other game fish: Statewide minimum size and daily limits apply.

(4) It is unlawful to fish from a floating device equipped with a motor.

## REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective July 1, 2015:

WAC 220-310-19500Q Exceptions to statewide rules—Upper Wheeler Reservoir.
