ORDER NO. 15-212

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-52-07300R Sea Urchins

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-52-073, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to take or possess sea urchins taken for commercial purposes except as provided for in this section:

(1) The following areas are open to green sea urchin harvest seven days-per-week: district 1 and district 2.

(2) It is unlawful to harvest green sea urchins smaller than 2.25 inches (size is largest test diameter exclusive of spines).

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

Reasons for this finding: Harvestable surpluses of green sea urchins exist in the districts specified to allow for commercial harvest. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules. (15-212, 7/15/2015)
