WAC 220-310-19500V Eastside – Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-310-195, it is unlawful to violate the provisions below. Unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect.

Klickitat River from the mouth (Burlington Northern Railroad Bridge) upstream to the Fisher Hill Bridge: Effective April 2 through May 30, 2016, daily limit will be 2 salmon or hatchery steelhead or one of each. In addition, fishing will be open only on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective May 31, 2016:

WAC 220-310-19500V Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Eastside.

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013 which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to correct an error in the permanent rule and to be consistent with the Department of Fish and Wildlife's Washington Sport Fishing Rules pamphlet. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules. (16-36, 3/4/2016)
