NEW SECTION

WAC 220-310-19000Y Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Langlois Lake.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-310-190, effective one hour before official sunrise to one hour after official sunset on April 16, 2016, it is permissible for anglers participating in the Project Healing Waters fishing event to fish is the waters of Langlois Lake. Statewide size and daily limits apply.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective one hour after official sunset on April 16, 2016:

WAC 220-310-19000Y Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Langlois Lake.

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

Reasons for this finding: Langlois Lake is being opened for one day of fishing to provide angling opportunity for Project Healing Waters which is dedicated to the physical and emotional rehabilitation of disabled active military service personnel and disabled veterans through fishing. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
