NEW SECTION

WAC 220-310-19000A Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-310-190, effective 12:01 a.m. June 1 through 11:59 p.m. June 5, 2016, it is unlawful to fish in those waters of Heart Lake, except open to fishing 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. June 4, 2016, to anglers participating in the youth fishing event. Juvenile anglers can continue to fish on June 6, 2016, after the youth fishing event closes.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective 12:01 a.m. June 6, 2016:

WAC 220-310-19000A Exceptions to statewide rules—Heart Lake (Skagit Co.)

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY
