WAC 220-310-19500W Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Eastside.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-310-195, effective 6:00 p.m. March 10, 2017, until further notice, the following waters are closed to fishing for whitefish:

- (1) **Entiat River:** From mouth (railroad bridge) to Entiat Falls.
- (2) **Similkameen River:** From mouth to Enloe Dam.
- (3) **Methow River:** From Gold Creek to falls above Brush Creek.
- (4) **Chewuch River:** From mouth (Winthrop, WA) to Pasayten wilderness boundary falls (river mile 34.6).
