NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-06000A Exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River sturgeon.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-060 and WAC 220-316-010, effective March 25, 2017, until further notice, it is unlawful to retain sturgeon caught in those waters of the Columbia River and tributaries from Bonneville Dam upstream to John Day Dam. Catch and release is permissible except from May 1, 2017, until further notice, in the sturgeon spawning Sanctuary located from The Dalles Dam downstream 1.8 miles and in the sturgeon spawning Sanctuary located from John Day Dam downstream 2.4 miles.
