WAC 220-312-02000A Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Coast.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-020, effective April 2 through April 7, 2017, it is unlawful to fish in the waters of Lincoln Park Pond (Clallam County).
