WAC 220-312-02000B Exceptions to statewide rules—Bowers Lake (Vance Creek Pond #1) Grays Harbor Co.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-020, effective April 1 through April 9, 2017, juveniles, holders of a senior license, and anglers with Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife disability status and who have a designated harvester card may fish in those waters of Bowers Lake (Vance Creek Pond #1).
