#### NEW SECTION

### WAC 220-312-02000C Exceptions to statewide rules—Failor Lake (Grays Harbor Co.)

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-020, Failor Lake is open to fishing on April 15, 2017, from 8:00 a.m. through 12:00 p.m. for anglers age fourteen years old and younger who are participating in the youth fishing event. Adults may assist children participating in the event, but no child may fish with more than one fishing rod. All other provisions of the permanent rule remain in effect.
