#### NEW SECTION

### WAC 220-312-02000D Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Coast.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-020, effective April 16 through June 30, 2017, it is unlawful to fish for salmon in those waters of the Chehalis River from the mouth (Hwy 101 Bridge) to the Hwy 6 Bridge in the town of Adna.
