NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-04000A Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Silver Lake.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective 6:20 a.m. through 8:00 p.m. April 15, 2017, it is permissible for anglers participating in the project Hero on the Waters NW Chapter fishing event to fish in the waters of Silver Lake (Pierce County). Unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect.
