NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-03000A Exceptions to statewide rules—Klineline Pond (Clark Co.)

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-030, effective 12:01 a.m. April 6 through April 8, 2017, it is unlawful to fish in those waters of Klineline Pond, except as provided in this section:

- (1) Open to fishing 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. April 7 and 8, 2017, in the netted area, to juvenile anglers participating in the Klineline Kids Fishing Event.
- (2) Daily limit of two fish.
