WAC 220-330-16000D Razor clams - Areas and Seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-160, it is unlawful to take, dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beaches in any razor clam area except as provided for in this section:

- (1) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 12, 2017 through 11:59 a.m. April 16, 2017 razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 1. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. only.
- (2) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 12, 2017 through 11:59 a.m. April 16, 2017 razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 3. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. only.
- (3) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 13, 2017 through 11:59 a.m. April 13, 2017 razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 4. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. only.
- (4) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 15, 2017 through 11:59 a.m. April 15, 2017 razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 4. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. only.
- (5) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 14, 2017 through 11:59 a.m. April 14, 2017 razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 5. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. only.
- (6) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 16, 2017 through 11:59 a.m. April 16, 2017 razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 5. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. only.
- (7) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in the Long Beach, Twin Harbors and Copalis Clam sanctuaries defined in WAC 220-320-130.
