#### NEW SECTION

### WAC 220-312-05000D Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Eastside.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-050, effective April 22 through July 16, 2017, the following rules apply in Mill Pond (Pend Oreille County):

- (1) Brook, Brown, Rainbow Trout and Burbot No minimum size or daily limit.
- (2) Other game fish Statewide minimum size and daily limit.
