WAC 220-313-06000B Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits. Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-313-060, it is unlawful to violate the provisions below. Unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect.

- (1) **Marine Area 7:** Daily limit of 2 salmon, no more than 1 Chinook. Release coho and wild Chinook. Closed April 22 through April 30.
- (2) **Marine Areas 8-1 and 8-2:** Effective immediately through April 30, daily limit of 2 salmon, no more than 1 Chinook. Release coho and wild Chinook.
- (3) **Marine Area 13:** Effective immediately until further notice, it is permissible to retain hatchery coho salmon as part of the daily limit.
