Reasons for this finding: An emergency rule is needed to open South Pond at the Bogachiel Hatchery because recent restrictions to the public access to Wentworth Lake, hatchery trout normally planted into Wentworth Lake are being planted in the South Pond which will provide additional angling opportunity. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
