#### NEW SECTION

### WAC 220-312-04000D Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective 12:01 a.m. May 31 through 11:59 p.m. June 3, 2017, it is unlawful to fish in those waters of Heart Lake, except open to fishing 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. June 3, 2016, to anglers participating in the youth fishing event. Juvenile anglers can continue to fish on June 3, 2017, after the youth fishing event closes.
