WAC 220-312-04000F Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective June 9 through September 30, 2017, it is unlawful to fish in those waters of the South Fork Nooksack River from the mouth to Skookum Creek.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective October 1, 2017:
