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WAC 220-312-06000P Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-060, it is unlawful to violate the following provisions provided that unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect:

- (1) Mainstem Columbia River from the Megler-Astoria Bridge upstream to The Dalles Dam, effective immediately until further notice:
 - (a) Night angling closure in effect except for anglers enrolled in the Pikeminnow Sport-Reward Program and actively fishing for pikeminnow.
 - (b) Through July 31, only 1 hatchery steelhead may be retained.
 - (c) Effective August 1 until further notice, release all steelhead.
- (2) Mainstem Columbia River from a true north-south line through Buoy 10 upstream to a line projected from Rocky Point on the Washington bank through Red Buoy 44 to the navigation light at Tongue Point on the Oregon bank, effective August 1 until further notice:
 - (a) Night angling closure in effect except for anglers enrolled in the Pikeminnow Sport-Reward Program and actively fishing for pikeminnow.
 - (b) Release all steelhead.
- (3) Mainstem Columbia River from The Dalles Dam upstream to the Hwy. 395 Bridge in Pasco: effective immediately until further notice:
 - (a) Night angling closure in effect except for anglers enrolled in the Pikeminnow Sport-Reward Program and actively fishing for pikeminnow.
 - (b) Only 1 hatchery steelhead may be retained.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed:

WAC 220-312-06000J Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River (17-119)

Reasons for this finding: These emergency rules are needed to apply restrictions to protect wild steelhead listed under the Endangered Species Act and to ensure enough hatchery steelhead return to meet escapement goals. The preseason forecast indicates approximately 130,700 summer-run steelhead will return to the Columbia River this year, the lowest number since 1980. This change allows night time bow hunting for carp. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
