WAC 220-312-02000H Freshwater exception to statewide rules - Coast.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-020, effective immediately until further notice, it is permissible to fish for salmon in those waters of the Bogachiel River from Mill Creek (upstream of the Bogachiel hatchery) to the Hwy. 101 Bridge. Daily limit of 6 salmon, of which 2 may be adults. Release wild Chinook and wild coho.
