EMERGENCY RULE Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:								
 That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest. That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule. 								
Reasons for this finding: A recent error with the department's drawing system allowed 89 additional elk hunters to draw a multi-season elk permit. The season for this hunt starts as early as September 9 which leaves the department insufficient time to engage in permanent rule making. The additional permits will have minimal to no impact on current elk population. The department will work toward improvements to the drawing system to avoid this happening in the future.
