Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:
That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health,
safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon
adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate
adoption of a rule.
Reasons for this finding:
The Department has adopted permanent rules necessary to implement the commercial fishing plans developed
through the North of Falcon season setting process. These rules are interim until permanent rules take effect.
Additionally, this emergency rule is needed to facilitate removal of Atlantic salmon a non-native species by
allowing a smaller mesh size for the commercial gillnet fisheries in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch
Reporting Area 7C. Cooke Aquaculture Pacific, the owner of net pen facility near Cypress Island, WA (near the
San Juan Islands) has indicated that structural damage to one of their Atlantic salmon net pens resulted in the
escape of Atlantic salmon adults. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
