#### NEW SECTION

### WAC 220-312-03000H Southwest – Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-030, effective September 16 through November 30, 2017 it is unlawful to fish in waters of the Wind River from 100 feet above Shipherd Falls to Moore Bridge.

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective December 1, 2017:
