Reasons for this finding: Due to recent forest fires in Eastern Washington, the U.S Forest Service has closed access to
most of the Naches Pass (3-6) mountain goat hunting area. This closure will likely remain in effect for most of the 2017
hunting season. By this emergency rule, the department seeks to allow holders of current mountain goat hunting permits for the Naches Pass mountain goat hunt area to hunt in 2018.
The Naches Fass mountain goat num area to hunt in 2010.
The department has specifically decided to re-issue goat hunting permits for the following reasons: 1) the small geographic
area in which goat hunts typically occur; 2) the likelihood that the entire Naches Pass will be legally closed to entry during the
2017 hunting season, and 3) the unlikelihood that holders of mountain goat special permits will have to draw a goat permit
again in the future. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-415-13000A Mountain goat seasons and permit quotas.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-415-130, effective immediately, until further notice, the following rules apply:

- (1) Due to the recent forest fires in Eastern Washington, the U.S Forest Service has closed access to most of the Naches Pass mountain goat hunt area (3-6, hunt #6002), and it is unlikely that the U.S. Forest Service will re-open access during the rest of the 2017 hunting season.
- (2) This rule allows current holders of mountain goat hunting permits for the Naches Pass mountain goat hunting area (3-6, hunt #6002) the option to return their permits to the department, which will then re-issue these permits to the same holders for the 2018 mountain goat hunting season.
