Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:						
safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon						
adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.

Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to close the commercial salmon fisheries in Salmon						
Management and Catch Reporting Areas 7 and 7A as per pre-season agreement with tribal co-managers based on						
the non-treaty chum catch to date in these areas. Additionally, there is not enough non-treaty share remaining to						
allow for multiple day openings. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
