EMERGENCY RULE

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to reopen the Hoh and South Fork Hoh rivers which were closed by filing WSR 17-21-054. Recent rainfall has normalized flows, allowing salmon to migrate upstream to spawning areas. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
