Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-030, effective November 1 through November 30, 2017, in the waters of the North Fork Toutle and Green Rivers (Cowlitz County):

Daily limit is 6 salmon, up to 2 may be adults, release salmon other than hatchery coho.
