Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is necessary because hatchery steelhead smolts released in the spring of
2016 and spring of 2017 into the Hoko river were not fin clipped. These fish will begin returning in the coming winter. Dorsal
fin heights of hatchery reared steelhead are shorter than comparably sized wild steelhead. The standard of 2 1/8 th inches has
been used elsewhere to identify hatchery steelhead when fin clips are lacking. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent
rules.

WAC 220-312-02000S Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Coastal.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-020, effective November 16, 2017 until further notice:

It is permissible to retain steelhead with a dorsal fin height of less than 2 1/8 inches or with an adipose or ventral fin clip.
