Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to close the commercial chum salmon fisheries in Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 7B due to concerns over low returns to the Nooksack River and Kendall Creek Hatchery. The closure is necessary to ensure natural escapement and hatchery broodstock goals are met. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
