WAC 220-312-05000E Exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia Park Pond. Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-05000B and WAC 220-312-050, effective 12:01 a.m. April 18, through 5:00 p.m. April 21, 2018, it is unlawful to fish in Columbia Park Pond (Kennewick), except as provided in the subsections below:

- (1) Open to fishing April 20, 2018, by registered juvenile anglers participating in the "Special Needs Youth Fishing Event".
- (2) Open to fishing April 21, 2018, by registered juvenile anglers participating in the "Kids' Fishing Day" event.
- (3) The daily limit is three trout during the two youth fishing events.
