Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-02000Y and WAC 220-312-020, effective 6:00 p.m. June 8 through 6:00 a.m. June 9, 2018, it is unlawful to fish in waters of Lake Sylvia (Grays Harbor Co.).
