WAC 220-312-04000L Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound. Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective June 2, 2018 until further notice:

Green (Duwamish) River (King County): from an east-west line extending through the southernmost tip of Harbor Island to the water pipeline walk bridge (1/2 mile downstream of Tacoma Headworks Dam); it is unlawful to retain steelhead.
