#### WAC 220-330-11000E Clams other than razor clams – Areas and seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-110, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to take, dig for and possess clams, cockles, and mussels taken for personal use from the following public tidelands except during the open periods specified herein:

- (1) Duckabush: Closed until further notice.
- (2) Kopachuck State Park: Open through May 31, 2018.
- (3) Joemma Beach State Park: Closed immediately until further notice.
- (4) Port Townsend Ship Canal/Portage Beach: Open through May 31, 2018.
- (5) West Penn Cove: Closed immediately until further notice.

#### NEW SECTION

#### WAC 220-330-14000E Oysters – Areas and seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-140, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to take and possess oysters taken for personal use from the following public tidelands except during the open periods specified herein:

- (1) Duckabush: Closed until further notice.
- (2) Kopachuck State Park: Open through May 31, 2018.
- (3) Joemma Beach State Park: Closed immediately until further notice.
- (4) Port Townsend Ship Canal/Portage Beach: Open through May 31, 2018.
- (5) West Penn Cove: Closed immediately until further notice.
