**Reasons for this finding:** Harvestable surplus of Chinook salmon is available in the Hoodspport Hatchery Zone for a commercial beach seine opening and only this portion of 12C is open. This emergency rule is necessary to define the geographic extent of the Hoodspport Hatchery Zone. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

NEW SECTION

**WAC 220-354-21000A Puget Sound salmon- Beach seine – Open periods.**

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-354-210, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to take, fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 12C except in accordance with the area indicated below. Unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect:

<b>Open Area</b>
Hoodsport Hatchery Zone, as defined as that portion of Area 12C within 2,000 feet of the western shore between the dock at Glen Ayr Recreational Vehicle Park and the Hoodsport Marina dock.
