WAC 220-500-14000A Firearms and Target Practicing.

- (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-500-140, effective August 4, 2018, until further notice, it is unlawful to discharge firearms on department owned or controlled lands unless engaged in lawful hunting.
- (2) Unless otherwise provided, violation of any of the provisions of this section constitutes an infraction, pursuant to RCW 77.15.020 and 77.15.160.
