#### NEW SECTION

### WAC 220-312-05000T Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Eastside.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-050, effective from one hour before official sunrise August 4 through one hour after official sunset September 30, 2018:

- (1) Entiat River (Chelan Co.); From mouth (rail road bridge) to boundary marker/markers located approximately 1,500 feet upstream of the upper roaring Creek Road Bridge (immediately downstream of the Entiat National Fish Hatchery):
- (a) Selective gear rules are not in effect.
- (b) It is permissible for anglers to use one line with up to 2 single point barbless hooks.
- (c) It is permissible for anglers to use bait.
