Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-354-160, effective August 12 through August 18, 2018, it is permissible to fish in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 9A with gillnet gear. Unless otherwise amended, all other permanent rules remain in effect.
