### WAC 220-354-21000C Puget Sound salmon—Beach seine—Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-354-210, effective August 30, 2018, until further notice it is unlawful to fish for salmon with commercial beach seine gear in Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Area 12C.
