Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective September 15, 2018, until further notice, it is unlawful to fish in the waters of the Samish River from the mouth (Bayview-Edison Road) to the I-5 Bridge. Unless otherwise amended, all other permanent rules remain in effect.
