Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to reopen fisheries of the lower Dungeness River to permanent rule. The fishery was closed to help ensure that hatchery coho broodstock needs would be achieved. With recent rains, river discharge has increased significantly resulting in good numbers of coho entering the hatchery and giving certainty that broodstock needs will be met. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
