EMERGENCY RULE

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

Reasons for this finding: After reviewing catches to date, co-managers agreed to open an additional day of commercial gillnet fishing in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas 12, 12B and 12C to harvest the remaining non-treaty share. This rule is needed to open 12, 12B, and 12C for an additional day to commercial gillnet fishing. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

WAC 220-354-16000Q Puget Sound salmon—Gillnet—Open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-354-160, it is unlawful to take, fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas except during the periods set forth in this section, provided that unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect:
