NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-04000D Exceptions to statewide rules – Puget Sound -- Nooksack River; Nooksack River, North Fork; Nooksack River, South Fork.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective November 28 through December 31, 2018, in those waters of the Nooksack River from the Lummi Indian Reservation boundary to the confluence of the North and South Forks, the North Fork Nooksack from the Highway 9 Bridge to Maple Creek – release chum salmon.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective January 1, 2019:
