NEW SECTION

WAC 220-330-16000U Razor clams - Areas and Seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-160, it is unlawful to take, dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beaches in any razor clam area except as provided for in this section:

- Effective 12:01 p.m. December 6, 2018 through 11:59 p.m. December 9, 2018, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 3. Digging is permissible from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (2) Effective 12:01 p.m. December 6, 2018 through 11:59 p.m. December 6, 2018 and 12:01 p.m. December 8, 2018 through 11:59 p.m. December 8, 2018 razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 4. Digging is permissible from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (3) Effective 12:01 p.m. December 7, 2018 through 11:59 p.m. December 7, 2018 and 12:01 p.m. December 9, 2018 through 11:59 p.m. December 9, 2018, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 5. Digging is permissible from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (4) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in the Twin Harbors and Copalis Beach Clam sanctuaries defined in WAC 220-320-130.
