NEW SECTION

WAC 220-330-16000C Razor clams – Areas and Seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-160, it is unlawful to take, dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beaches in any razor clam area except as provided for in this section:

- (1) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 6, 2019 through 11:59 a.m. April 7, 2019, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 3. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. each day only.
- (2) Effective 12:01 a.m. April 6, 2019 through 11:59 a.m. April 8, 2019, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 5. Digging is permissible from 12:01 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. each day only.
- (3) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in the Twin Harbors Razor Clam sanctuaries defined in WAC 220-320-130.

REPEALER
